Confidence of colleague's Google Classroom Use

H. Confident - Highly Confident:

Work is always posted on the Google Classroom before timetabled lessons (evidence of scheduling seen). Instructions are very clear and easy for students to interpret. A wide range of teaching strategies have been used frequently (e.g. powerpoints, pre recorded videos, Google Meets and potentially other methods on top). Assignments are being used regularly (or other suitable alternative); students given meaningful feedback. May be able to contribute to GC CPD programme for others.

Confident - Confident:

Work is virtually always posted on the Google Classroom before timetabled lessons (evidence of scheduling seen). Instructions are mostly clear and effective for students to interpret. A range of teaching strategies have been used (e.g. some attempt to use powerpoints, pre-recorded videos and/or Google Meet or other suitable methods). Some evidence of assignments being used (or other suitable alternative). CPD throughout the year will continue to add value.

Developing - Developing Confidence:

Work is inconsistently posted on the Google Classroom before timetabled lessons. Instructions can be brief and sometimes difficult to understand for students. A limited range of teaching methods have been used. No evidence of assignments having been used with students yet. Further GC related CPD potentially require.
