




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Headings – this helps you create sections within your templates and keep them organised. These headings will not be shown in reports.

Student data can always be uploaded directly to records via "View Mode" this allows for information to be kept within the one place.

This field is a dropdown box with the options of Yes or No.

Agreed Focus information is useful to include on individual records but does not need to be quantified within reports.

Evaluation

1. Subject and curriculum knowledge (TS3)

- -Understanding of component knowledge required to shape & adjust the lesson to meet pupils' needs as the lesson progresses -Reference to prior learning & how lesson fits into the intended big picture
- -Use of effective strategies to retrieve & practise previously learned skills & knowledge.
- -Lesson is correctly sequenced in the scheme of work
- -Sequenced so that pupils accumulate knowledge, understanding & skills to secure insure learning
- -Strategies to support reading/vocab/numeracy




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

The "Add" option included in focus areas, allows for staff to engage with their records. Evidence can be uploaded such as Lesson resources; Photos of work; PowerPoints etc.




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

The inclusion of this focus area allows for the identification of CPD needs for all staff members. This allows for easy identification for busy Leaders to view what is required within their establishment.


Any comments entered into a focus area by an observer will pull through into the details section of reports. These can then be viewed without the need to click into individual records.



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Focus Areas
Reflection

Rather than allowing staff a general reflection, the description for this focus area has specific questions for the Observee to reflect on. Observers could also add any additional questions for reflections within the comments.



Reflections can be created by both Observer and Observee. In this case, the Observee would be able to add their reflections to the record once it has been published.

Actions could also be used to set a deadline for when reflections need to be entered onto a record by.
