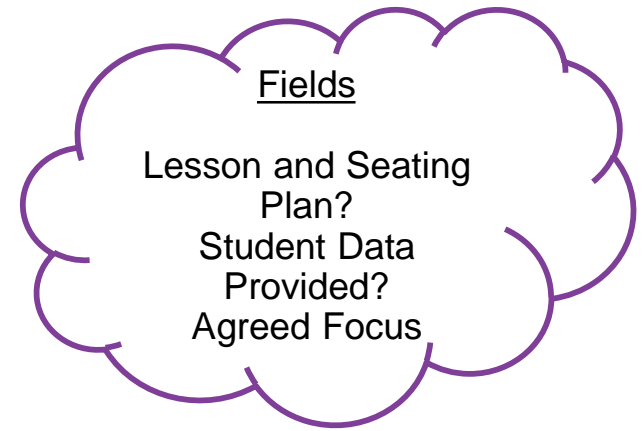

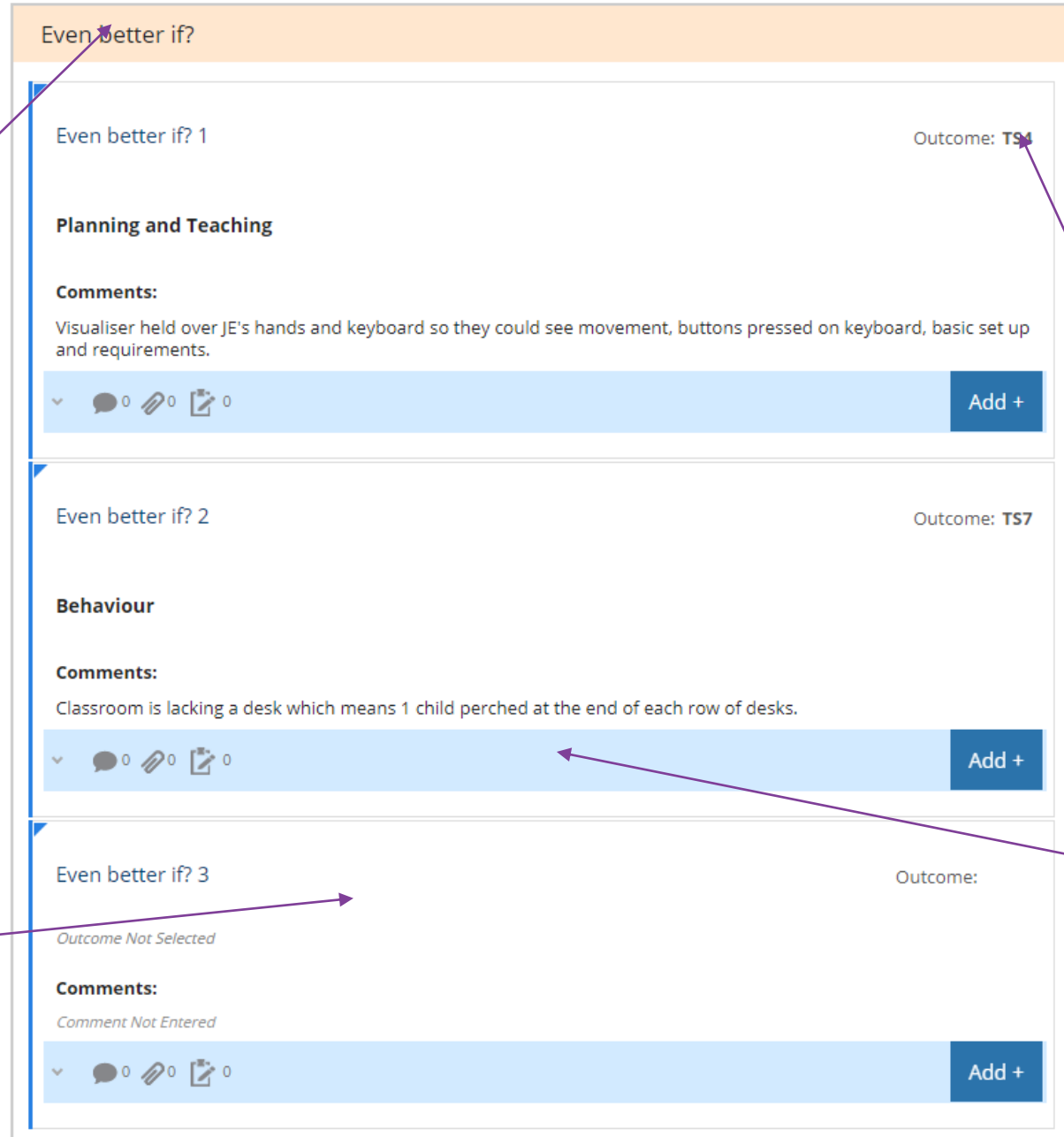

Actions could also be used to set a deadline for when reflections need to be entered onto a record by.

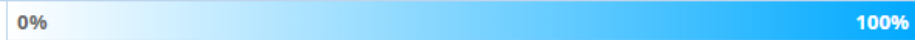
