

This outcome set helps to highlight to leaders when support may be needed and who could be used as a potential Online Teaching Coach while also keeping the form quick and easy to complete.




This outcome allows for easy identification of key aspects of a lesson and to easily pinpoint areas of good practice and practice which could be developed.

The "Add" option included in focus areas, allows for staff to engage with their records. Evidence can be uploaded such as Lesson resources; Photos of work; PowerPoints etc.





