
This template could be used as a single working document staff continuously add to, or it could be tweaked into a weekly mentoring document.



Any comments made within a focus area will pull through into the details section of the reports.




Teacher Standards 5 – Differentiation



Some schools may choose to include TS9 but this example hasn't.





This document allows continual reflection on Observations, Learning Walks and Book Looks.


It could also be altered to focus on weekly observations for ITT students.


This outcome set also provides a great opportunity to encourage peer mentoring and in house CPD sessions.



Mentors may then be able to implement CPD for further development.






