This template focuses on three main aspects of a lesson: Behaviour, challenge and progress. Additional focus areas could be added or the existing ones can be renamed depending on your school set up.

Support LAP Challenge HAP [SUP/CH]

- The teacher identifies and supports those pupils who start to fall behind and intervenes quickly to help them to improve their learning.
- Pupils are given time to apply their knowledge and understanding in ways that stretches their thinking, and to practise key skills.

Focus areas allow for staff to engage with their records without being able to edit the observers' notes. Staff can use the "View" mode to add reflections, upload resources or create actions.

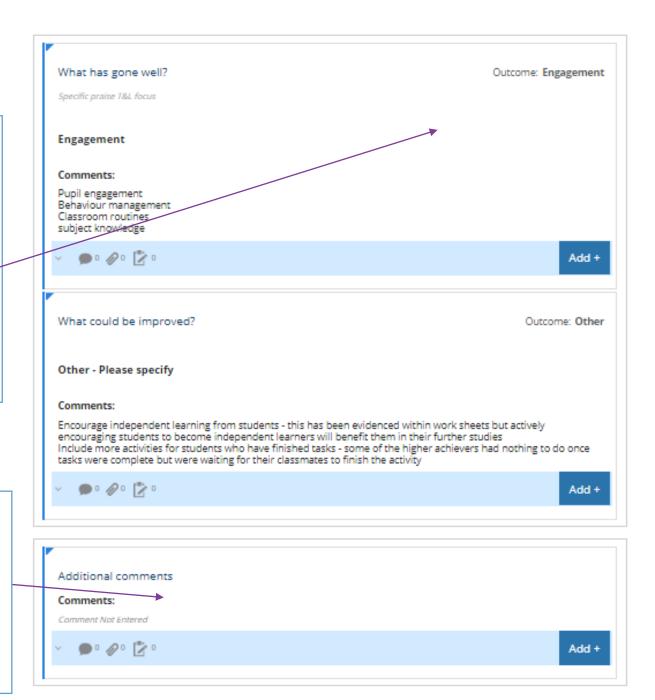
