A RAG rated form focusing on 4 key areas when assessing books.





Focus areas allow for staff to engage with their records without being able to edit the observers' notes. Staff can use the "View" mode to add reflections, upload resources or create actions.



Schools no longer have to use the traditional Ofsted grading any more Outcome sets can be customised depending on your school processes and how you would like to assess QA processes within your school.

Comments can be entered which can be viewed in the details reports. Focus areas also allows for staff to be able to reflect on these notes and upload supporting evidence such as seating plans or photos of student work.




